



HOW TO MAKE A WREATH

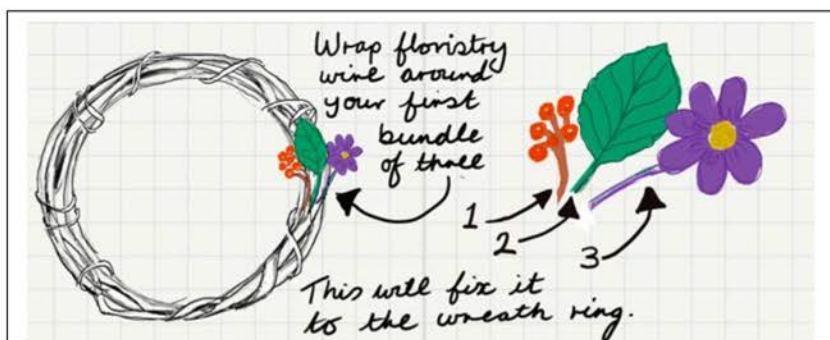
To make a wreath the materials you will need are a wreath ring (made with grapevine is more attractive) floristry wire, string, foraged foliage, or flowers (fresh or dried).

Tools you need: scissors, wire cutters, and pruners.

Foraging for natural materials is most fun and rewarding when making wreaths. These are the UK foraging laws.

You can buy the above materials and tools at markets floristry shops and Amazon.



Once you have gathered your foliage divide into bundles of three different types as above, red berries (1), green leaves (2), purple flower (3). Add 1 2 and 3 to the wreath ring and wrap with the floristry wire (don't cut the wire). Now add the next 1 2 and 3 keeping them in the same position. So, 1 is on the inside, 2 in the middle and 3 on the outer edge. Continue until you have a half moon shape or a full wreath. Congratulations you are finished!
